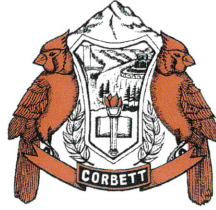

Dear Parents/Guardians of MAIN CAMPUS middle school and high school students,

It's time to register for the 2018-19 school year! We are pleased to let you know that you and your student(s) can come anytime from 9 am – 3 pm on Monday 8/6, Tuesday 8/7, or Thursday 8/9 in the multi-purpose building. Students need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian so all paperwork can be properly signed. Both middle school and high school students can register at the same time!

What to expect:

1. Photos: ALL students need to have their picture taken for an ID card and our electronic information system. Optionally, picture order packets will be available and payment can be made to LifeTouch. Limited photo retakes will be held on September 19th, only for those students who missed registration day or are ordering photo packets and want a retake. *Students who simply don't like the photo on their ID card cannot get photos retaken.*
2. Fees: Cash or checks for school fees – separate checks will be needed for middle school, high school, and lunch fees. Booster sport fees collected via online payment only. Visit www.CorbettBoostersClub.com.
3. Forms: Many need to be completed each year so we have the most up to date information.
 - New students should pick up a “New Student Registration Packet” available at any time in the District Office, or during the registration dates listed above.
 - Student Profile Form: Parents/guardians of returning students will be asked to review a printout of the contact information currently on file. Updates should be noted or “No Changes” noted, and the paper signed.
 - Forms you can download online, complete, and bring with you:
 - a) Federal Programs Questionnaire (Language Survey)
 - b) Middle School or High School Fee Schedule
 - c) Notice of Understanding to Obey Student Code of Conduct
 - d) Personally Identifiable Information (high school only)
 - e) Vehicle Registration (only for those high schoolers who will drive to school)
 - f) Student Agreement for an Electronic Communications System Account
 - g) Media Consent and Release
 - h) Medical Statement for Accommodating Disabilities
 - i) School Sports Pre-Participation Examination
 - j) Bus Riding

4. Locker Assignments:

- Middle School locker assignments will be made by the teachers on the first day of school.
- Gr. 9 – 11 locker assignments will be made at registration.
- Seniors needing lockers will be assigned them during the second week of September.

5. Teacher Assignments:

- Middle School assignments will be confirmed the first day of school.
- High School schedules were created and distributed during the 2017-18 year.
If you need to make a change please Dr. Pearson ASAP at his table during registration.


6. Lunches: Sign up for your MealTime lunch account. If you believe your family might qualify, please complete a Free and Reduced Lunch application. Some benefits beyond lunch are:

- Reduced or waived athletic fees
- Reduced or waived college application fees
- Reduced or waived SAT fees

7. Sports: Visit the Booster table for all of your sports needs, and to purchase any “team spirit” t-shirts, caps, or sweatshirts. All athletic registration and fee payments will be handled by Boosters. Visit www.CorbettBoostersClub.com for additional information.

Again, registration will be from 9 am – 3 pm on Monday 8/6, Tuesday 8/7, and Thursday 8/9 in the multi-purpose building. The first full day of school for all students will be Tuesday, August 28th, at 7:55 am.
