Future Plans: Testing for lead in drinking water will occur every ten years and as new building facilities are acquired.

5. Lead Paint

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule, the district will contract with certified contractors to perform the work.

6. Integrated Pest Management

The district has adopted an Integrated Pest Management plan as required by ORS 634.700 through 634.750. Community members can obtain a copy of the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) plan in the Corbett School District Office.

7. Communication

The district will make all test results and detailed information explaining the test results available to the public within five business days of receiving the results. Results will be made available by posting the results on the district website, sending notice of the results over the email system, and making the results available in hardcopy at the Corbett School District Office.
