

## Corbett School District Safe Return to In Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Summary August, 2021



<u>Corbett School District's Reopening Plan</u> is based on Oregon Department of Education's (ODE) Ready Schools Safe Learners Resiliency Framework. This guidance is updated periodically and the plan will be revised to reflect those updates as needed. It will be submitted to ODE and is posted on the district's website.

## The major components of Corbett's plan include:

- Frequent reminders to families to keep students home if they have any COVID-19 or other excludable symptoms such as: cough, fever, difficulty breathing, or loss of taste/smell. (Can My Student Go To School Today?)
- Follow up phone calls from the school nurse to parents/guardians of sick students to determine if there is a need to quarantine, and a return to school date.
- Visual health screenings as students enter the school buildings.
- <u>Isolation and exclusion protocols</u> for sick students or staff.
- Record keeping systems to assist in contact tracing.
- Face coverings required for all individuals while indoors during school hours and on the school bus regardless of vaccination status.
- Face coverings are not required for students outdoors during school hours, but are allowed.
- Frequent outside mask breaks are encouraged.
- Accommodations for students with medical needs or disabilities to the face covering requirement following specific guidelines.
- Hand washing/sanitizing emphasized throughout the day.
- A school nurse and school health assistant on campus full time.
- Free, on-site COVID-19 diagnostic testing offered to students (with parent/guardian permission) and staff with symptoms or exposure to COVID-19.
- Physical distancing protocols to provide 3 feet between students as much as possible (both indoors and outdoors).
- Stable cohorts of students maintained when possible.
- Frequent communication with families regarding plans, and protocols for informing families if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the school.
- Cleaning routines following CDC guidelines and janitors on site during the day.
- Increased ventilation in the buildings and on the busses whenever possible.
- Continued meal service (meals served in the cafeteria).
- Students participating in indoor sports are not required to wear a face covering while actively practicing or competing
- Face coverings required indoors and outdoors for spectators attending athletic or other events.
